

## **Studying under the Live-In Caregiver Program**

*This instruction sheet explains the law in general. It is not intended as legal advice for your particular problem. Because each person's situation is different, you may need to seek legal advice.*

### **Can I study while completing the Live-In Caregiver Program ('LCP')?**

Generally, foreign nationals including live in caregivers have to apply for study permits in order to study in Canada. However, caregivers pursuing courses that are less than six months in duration do not need to apply for a study permit to do so.

Caregivers interested in pursuing courses that are more than six months in duration have to apply for a study permit.

### **I want to enroll in a two-day first aid course. Do I need a study permit?**

You do not need to have a study permit to enroll for a two day course.
